OVERVIEW

Project Name: RORETRA

RORETRA is a journey of mathematical and dance transformations. For this project, the influence comes from the mathematical transformations of Rotation, Reflection, and Translation and how we can create contemporary dance movements inspired by them. How can we make the rigid transformations fluid? The interpretation consists of periodic patterns. The duet gradually uses the same motives of Rotation-Reflection-Translation and fills the whole space.

The three types of transformations are mixed and not always in the same order but almost always melt with each other. Sometimes one of the two dancers is the transformer and the other is the transformed. We use those three transformations not only in space but also in the movement itself. The long version of the performance is 20 minutes, but it is divided into four different patterns with four individual stories, which is why the performance can be presented in shorter versions.

This takes the spectators on a journey of an abstract mathematical and dancing transformations world and exploration of how those two worlds are interconnected.

Objectives

- Create a choreographic identity/language
- · Adaptable performance to any venue
- Showcase physicality/technicality of dancers



Dancer




